Kick off your holiday season with the Fantasy Lights WALK Sneak Preview.

Start and finish the 2.5 miles at Sprinker Recreation Center. Walkers may start any time between 5:00-7:00 p.m. after checking in.

Walkers should park and meet in Sprinker's parking lot located at 14824 So. C Street in Spanaway, then proceed as directed into Spanaway Park. Please note that parking may be an issue, so gather up your friends and family to carpool to the Walk!

Fee:

- **\$3 per person or \$9 per family of four must pre-register by November 16.** Children ages 3 and under are free. Pre-registered walkers will pick up their tickets the evening of the event at Spanaway Park.
- **\$4 per person or \$12 per family of four day of event.** Children ages 3 and under are free.
- **\$2.00 per person Group Rate.** Available for groups of 20 or more with one group leader registering and paying the entire fee. Group rates must be paid by November 16, no exceptions. Tickets can be purchased and picked up at the Parks Admin office in the Lakewood Community Center during normal business hours. The office is closed on Nov. 11 in honor of Veteran's Day.

Walk Policies:

- Walk only with strollers, wagons or wheelchairs.
- Please NO dogs, except service dogs. Please have service dogs clearly marked to prevent confusion by other walkers and volunteer staff.
- No scooters, in-line skates, skateboards, or bikes.
- Bring a flashlight and wear visible clothing.
- Event goes on rain or shine. Dress for the weather. No refunds due to inclement weather.
- Bring your camera for a memorable holiday picture.
- No vendors are allowed without written approval from the Pierce County Parks and Recreation Department.
