Pierce County Public Works and Utilities together with the Environmental Officials of the City of University Place and Pierce County have issued a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) to provide analysis to support the proposed expansion of the Chambers Creek Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP).

The Draft EIS provides analysis of proposed improvements and expansions of the WWTP for the next 30 years for the treatment and processing of materials collected from the Chambers Creek–Clover Creek Sewer Service Basin. Your review and comments concerning this document are important to ensure that all significant impacts have been identified.
