

## **Pierce County Comprehensive Plan 2003 Amendment Process**

The County's Comprehensive Plan provides guidance for future growth and development throughout unincorporated Pierce County, and is the basis for our Development Regulations and Zoning Atlas. Because the Plan is intended to provide certainty for residents and developers alike, the ability to change the Plan is limited to once every 2 years. After the 2003 cycle, the next County Council application deadline will be December 1, 2004.

Residents and property owners may suggest amendments to the Plan at any time; however, formal applications must be submitted to the Council before December 2, 2002, to be considered for adoption during the 2003 amendment process.

You can request:

1. Changes in the location of the urban growth boundary.
2. Changes in the land use designation and zoning of specific parcels of land.
3. Changes in the policies.
