

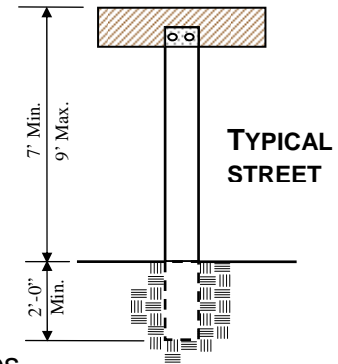

Street Sign Requirements

1. The sign shall be of metal material that conforms to the Washington State Department of Transportation standards (sheet aluminum alloy 50502-H36, 5052-H38, or 6061-T6, 0.08" thick).
2. The size of the sign shall be a minimum of 18 inches in length and 8 inches in height.
3. The minimum letter size on a sign shall be as follows:
 - a. The words "Private Road" 2 inches
 - b. The direction, avenue or street 3 inches
 - c. The road name 4 inches (See Exhibit A attached)
4. The color of the sign shall be as follows:
 - a. Background-- green reflective
 - b. Letters--white reflective (See Exhibit A attached)
5. The sign shall be painted with the street name on both sides.



SIGN POST REQUIREMENTS

1. Sign posts shall be of minimum dimension, 4x4 pressure-treated lumber, or cedar, standard or better grade.
2. The footing for the post shall be a minimum of 24 inches in depth.
3. The maximum height of the sign post from the finished grade to the bottom of the sign shall not exceed 9 feet. The minimum height shall be not less than 7 feet.

The sign post shall be placed not less than 10 feet, and not more than 30 feet from the edge of either right of way.
