

Amendment to Pierce County Development Regulations, Title 18I, Natural Resource Lands, Right to Farm

June 12, 2002

On August 28, 2001, the Pierce County Council adopted Resolution R2001-123, which directed the Pierce County Farm Advisory Commission to develop proposed right to farm legislation. The ordinance would ensure that agricultural operations in Pierce County are further protected from nuisance claims when new development has encroached the agricultural operations. The recommendation supports and encourages continued agricultural operations in Pierce County by establishing methods of disclosure, grievances, and penalties. The ordinance is available for public review and will be heard by the Pierce County Planning Commission on June 25, 2002.
