Draft Frederickson Community Plan Complete for Public Review

Residents and business owners of the Frederickson area will have an opportunity **April 16 and 17** to review the Frederickson Community Plan. This plan recommends to the County Council and County Executive a direction as to how Frederickson will evolve into the future. An Open House will be held from **4:30 to 7 p.m.** and a public meeting will follow from **7-8 p.m.** at **Clover Creek Elementary School**, 16715 36th Avenue East.

The Frederickson Community Planning Board is a group of citizens representing a variety of interests from the Frederickson community. The group has been preparing a community plan for the past three years and their recommendation is ready for public review.

The open house is an opportunity for citizens to review the proposed community plan and provide input that county planners say is vital to the community plan's development. Citizens will be able to talk with board members and county staff about tough issues related to policies and regulations related to land use, the natural environment, economic development, community character, and public facilities and services.

The event is being hosted by the Frederickson Community Planning Board and Pierce County Planning and Land Services.
