**LAND USE ADVISORY COMMISSIONS**

Pat McCarthy, Pierce County Executive, continues her visits with the various Land Use Advisory Commissions. The last visit was September 28, 2009, at the Frederickson Commission. Ms. McCarthy was informative on the various Pierce County activities and accomplishments. Her staff are dedicated to public service and listening to citizens and their concerns. The next Land Use Advisory Commission meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday, October 21, 2009, at the Key Peninsula.

There have not been any training workshops for the Commissions scheduled at the present time.

**PERFORMANCE OF REVIEW FOR SEPTEMBER 2009**

Current Planning still has a backlog that staff continues to work towards reducing. At the end of September there was a backlog of 70 reviews. There were 160 reviews performed on time, giving the Section a performance measure of 58.39%.

There were 175 new reviews submitted in September that have an initial review timeline of 30 or 60 days. These reviews have an impact on staff in October or November. Last month the new reviews filed were 177. It appears that August and September have stayed consistent. We reviewed more single-family residential applications and less commercial applications in September than we did in August. The other application types for land use appear to be consistent in the last several months.
